






Detective Sgt. Steve Barber Burglary Case Reviews & Arrests






Location: 3700 blk. Via Valmonte; October 28, 2015, 3:00 p.m.

Incident Summary: Resident called to report suspicious activity in his neighborhood. Officers responded and located a vehicle leaving the area and subsequently arrested the pictured suspects for burglary.



Location: 800 blk. Paseo Lunado; October 29, 2015, at 1:39 a.m.

Incident Summary: Resident called to report the above pictured suspect in her rear yard pounding on her door. Officer responded and subsequently arrested the suspect for burglary.





Location: 1200 blk Palos Verdes Drive West; November 12, 2015 at 3:43 a.m.

Incident Summary: An officer on patrol noticed two suspicious subjects standing near a parked vehicle. After witnessing a minor infraction, he contacted the two. This contact lead to the discovery of stolen mail in and around the vehicle. Both were arrested for mail theft.

ARRESTED

Location: 700 blk. Via Del Monte; November 13, 2015, at 8:58 p.m.

Incident Summary: Resident called to report suspicious vehicles/subjects in the area. Officers responded and checked the area and found evidence of a burglary. Officers subsequently located a suspect in a nearby business and arrested him for burglary.



Location: 1000 blk. Via Ventana; November 25, 2015, at 9:31 a.m.

Incident Summary: Resident called to report a suspicious person in her rear yard. Officers responded, checked the area and located the suspect in the area. She was subsequently arrested for burglary.





Location: 3000 block of Palos Verdes Drive North; November 26, 2015, at 11:16 p.m.


Incident Summary: An officer on patrol stopped a vehicle for a traffic infraction. Through his investigation, the two subjects were arrested for possession of burglary tools and stolen property.



Location: 2000 block of Via Visalia; November 27, 2015, at 7:28 p.m.

Incident Summary: The above picture suspect was identified as being involved in a burglary that turned into an armed robbery when the homeowner interrupted the crime.





Location: 800 blk. Victoria Place; December 3, 2015, at 11:21 a.m.

Incident Summary: Resident called to report a suspicious vehicle parked in the area and suspicious people knocking on a neighbors door. Officers responded, checked the area and located evidence of a burglary. One suspect was arrested after fleeing the area in a vehicle. Additional suspect was arrested through detective follow-up investigation.



Location: 2000 blk. Paseo Del Mar; December 6, 2015; 8:53 a.m.

Incident Summary: An officer on patrol noticed a suspicious vehicle parked in the driveway of a residence he knew was unoccupied. A check of the property revealed that a rear sliding door was open. During the check of the property, a female suspect was contacted and subsequently arrested for burglary.





Location: 3200 blk. Palos Verdes Drive North, November 5 – 6, 2015; 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m.

Incident Summary: The above picture suspect was identified as being involved in a theft from a vehicle. Arrested on December 8, 2015.



DOOR TO DOOR SALES & SOLICITORS




- Could be "Knock Knock Burglar" checking to see if someone is home, or casing neighborhood




